

OPWC GRANT TO FUND ONE LANE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT



Monroe Township Trustees, Brandstetter-Carol, Inc., and The Clermont County Engineers Office have been working cooperatively to acquire an Ohio Public Works Grant to replace the dangerous one lane bridge at the intersection of State Route 222 and Berry Road.

This bridge and intersection has been high on the Monroe Township Trustee's safety concerns because of the volume of traffic and sight distance issues.

According to Clermont County Engineer's Department spokes person, Todd Gadbury, the one lane bridge will be replaced and upgraded to a two lanes bridge. The bridge should be completed during the 2011 Clermont County bridge replacement cycle.
